FLEBOGRIF®

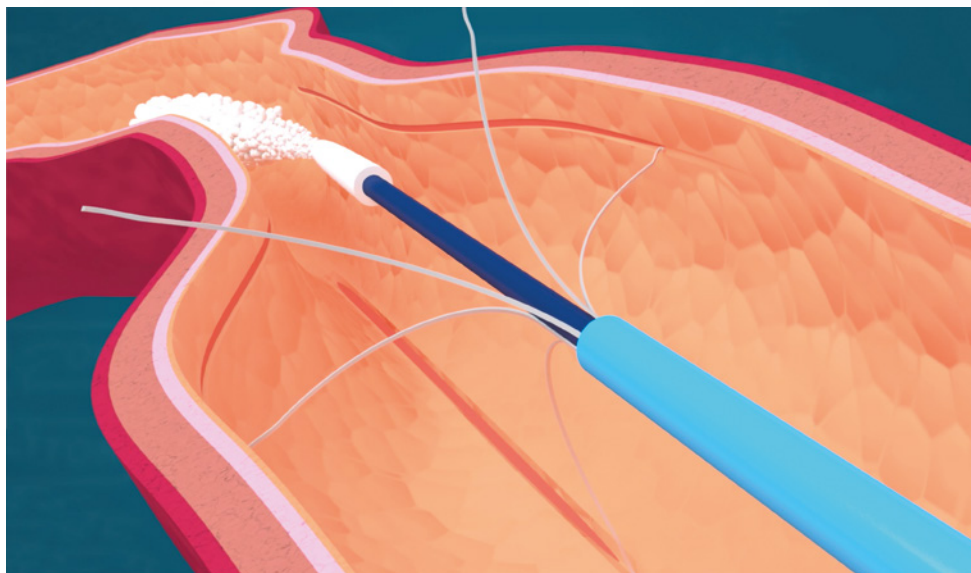
Flebogrif® is one of the latest methods of treatment for the varicose veins of the lower extremities. It consists of two mechanisms – mechanical and chemical, which effectively close diseased and inefficient vein.

During the procedure under Doppler ultrasound, vein endothelial irritation occurs with simultaneous administration of sclerosing agent (foam), which causes contraction of the treated vein and closing of the varicose vein.*

The Flebogrif® treatment is a highly effective and minimally invasive method.

It only requires local anaesthesia and it does not leave any scars.

* The method of treatment is selected by the doctor depending on the individual needs and clinical situation of the patient and after qualification for procedure.



Advantages:

- Short time procedure
- Quick return to daily activities and professional work
- Can be done on an outpatient basis
- Good cosmetic effect
- Non-thermal procedure (without the use of high temperatures) that is considered painless from the patients

Preparation for procedure:

- Preoperative USG/Doppler examination
- Usage of the compression products most often Class II compression
- General medical examination

After procedure:

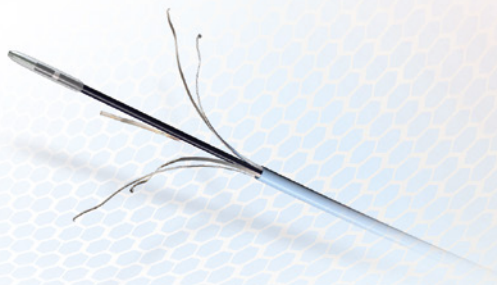
- Compression according to the Doctor's evaluation
- Patients are observed for a few hours and then can go back home

Recommendations:

- To wear compression products for weeks.
- To maintain physical activity, preferably moderate daily walking.
- No direct sun exposure for weeks.
- No sick leave required, quick return to daily activities and professional work.
